Public Comment: Hollice Clark read the resignation of Commissioner Wayne Delabre. Darrel Bruck stated he believes in small government and low taxes and does not want the board to renew Clark's contract. Stevie Hunter, Vice President of the NAACP stated he was there to observe. Robert Romo stated he is disappointed by the last financial statement that was released by BTPD and went on to explain why. Clark Gregoire stated he was a Commissioner for 4 ½ years and during that time one board member that is still on the board voted yes to everything that was spent at the park district.

Hebert asked if there was a motion at 5:38 pm to go into close session on the items pertaining to 5 ILCS 120/2 (1) (Personnel) The appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, dismissal, performance or personal status of employees. Zinanni made the motion, Bukowski seconded. Roll Call: Bukowski-AYE, Zinanni-AYE, Settle-AYE, Delabre-ABSENT, Hebert-AYE. Motion carried.

Hebert asked if there was a motion to reconvene. Zinanni made the motion and Bukowski seconded. Meeting reconvened at 6:18 pm. Roll Call: Bukowski- AYE, Zinanni-AYE, Settle-AYE, Delabre-ABSENT, Hebert-AYE. Motion carried.

Hebert asked Settle to go ahead. Settle stated he would like to make the motion to not renew Hollice Clark's contract that ends on April 2022 and stated the Attorney will communicate that decision to Clark. Zinanni seconded. Roll Call: Bukowski- AYE, Zinanni-AYE, Settle- AYE, Delabre-ABSENT, Hebert-AYE. Motion carried.

Hebert asked if there was a motion to adjourn. Clark asked if he could read a statement. Clark then read his departure letter.

Motion to adjourn at 6:28 pm was made by Zinanni, seconded by Settle. All in favor, Motion carried.
